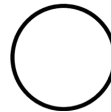

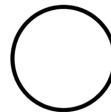

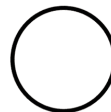
The Jews were trusting in themselves for salvation. But God brought good results from evil. *Draw the appropriate face for each result.*



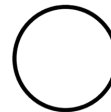
-1. Salvation came to the Gentiles (non-Jews).

-3. Some Jews turned to God in faith and repentance.



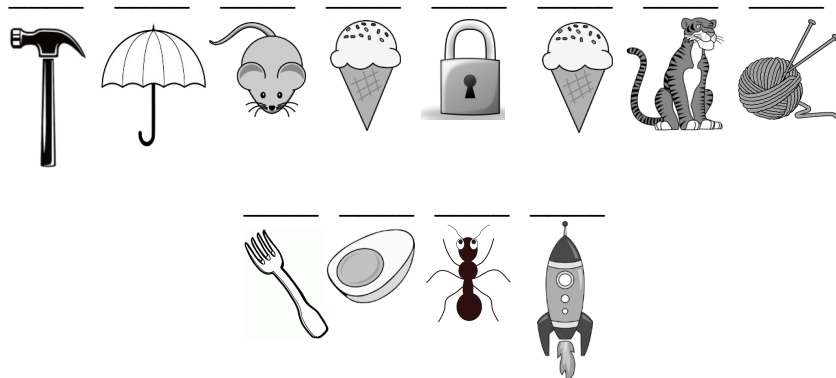
-4. The whole world is blessed.
