






A famine swept the land of Israel. So a certain Israelite man moved his wife and two sons to Moab. Moab had food, but its people worshiped idols. The man and his sons died.

Both went with Naomi.






One daughter-in-law kissed Naomi and went back to her people. Write the first letter of each picture below to read her name.
