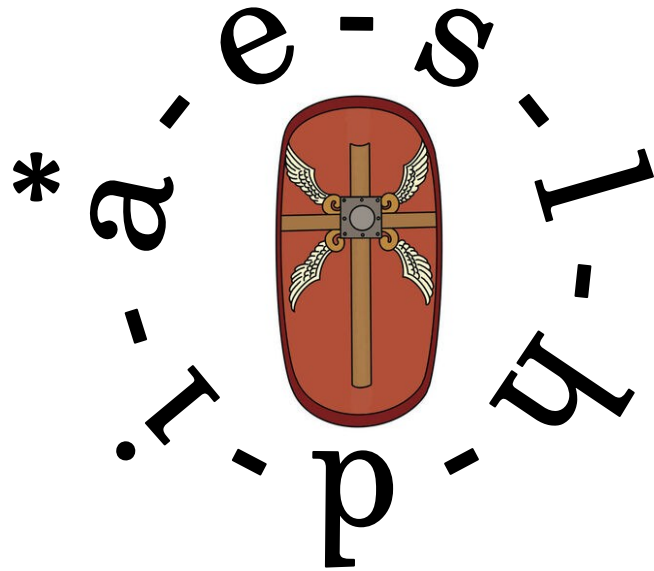


Children's Bulletin

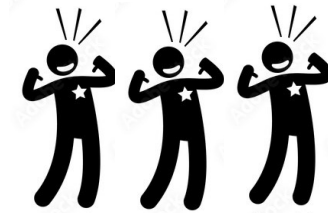
