

One way to prepare your mind for action is to worship the Lord with your church family every Sunday! *Check off what you did today.*

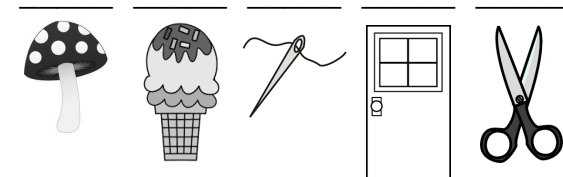
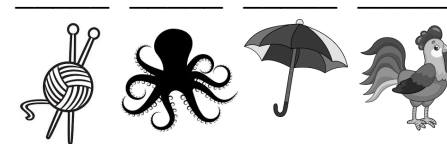

holy.

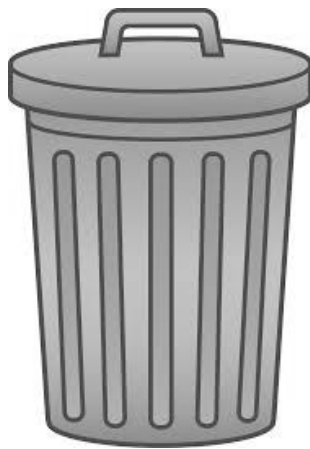
