- **Officer Elections Process:** The Session is preparing for the nomination and election process for 2026 officers (Elder, Deacon, Treasurer and Congregational Chairman). Note, all names submitted will be considered but the Session acts as the nomination committee and is not bound to include them in the final list of candidates to be presented at our congregational meeting on January 25 (see below).

On **January 25**, we will have our annual congregational meeting for the purpose of approving the budget for 2026 as well as officer elections (see announcement above).
