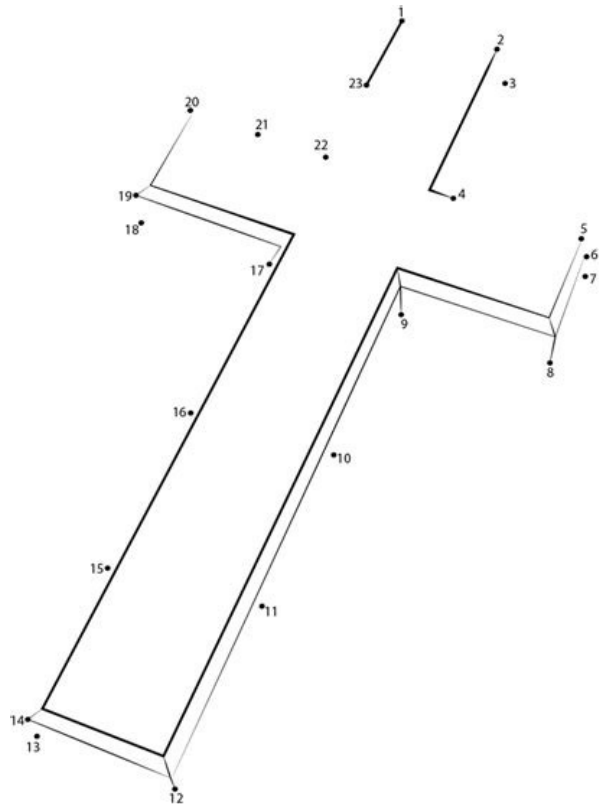




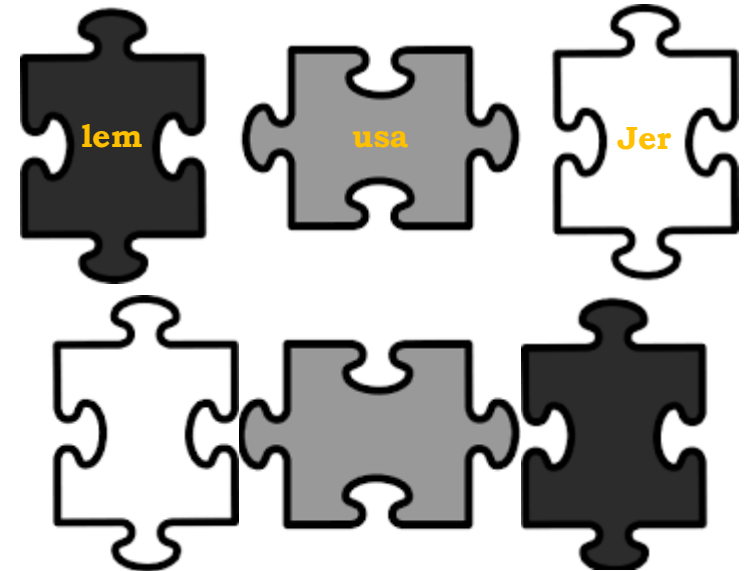

## What's so special about Jerusalem?

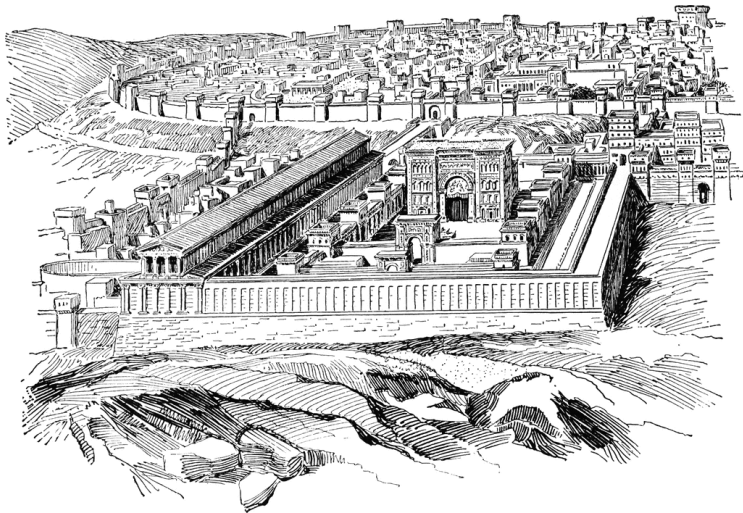
*Cross out the incorrect words.*
